Election Details

This is a Special Election that is specific to the Town of Ramapo. The date and details of this election were set forth in a vote by the town board on August 21 (which wasn't available for weeks!) which you can find here: Ward Referendum Resolution

Voter Registrations due September 23th (New Registrations and Changes) Registered Voters:

Don't assume you are registered to vote or that your friends or neighbors are properly registered to vote.

So check your voter registration status immediately at the the New York State Board of Elections voter look up page.

The voter registration form should be used as a change of address form.

Unregistered Voters - PLEASE REGISTER:

The Town of Ramapo has included in their notice that registrations submitted to the Board of Elections by September 23rd will be processed.

Absentee Ballots

The information is in. To get an Absentee Ballot from the Town of Ramapo you must fill out an Ramapo Special Election Absentee Application Form. The form must be sent with an original signature (no scans and emails allowed).

If you want the Town of Ramapo to mail the form to you, the application must be sent in by September 23.

If you hand deliver the Absentee Ballot Application Form the deadline is September 29. So if last minute plans will keep you out of the you can literally go in on the Monday before the election and request the ballot, fill it out and submit it.
